The Pear Blossom Festival's Pedals 'n Pears Bike Ride is the perfect event for Families, the Weekend Warrior Rider and the Expert Rider alike.



All distances start from Medford's Bear Creek Park on the Bear Creek Greenway.

The Comice-Family Ride

(approx. 4 miles)

Takes the Bear Creek Greenway to Coyote Trails School of Nature at US Cellular Parks for a rest stop, educational games and turn around.



The Bosc Ride (approx. 14 miles)

Takes South Stage Road to the Griffin Creek area and Carpenter Hill Road that hold Medford's original pear orchards.



The Bartlett Ride (approx. 30 miles)

Takes South Stage Road to the Griffin Creek area, then loops through the rolling hills of Dark Hollow, Pioneer Road and Carpenter Hill Road that hold Medford's original pear orchards, along with new vineyards.



The Royal Riviera-Metric Century

(approx. 62 mi.) Takes South Stage Road to the Griffin Creek area, then to Sterling Creek and through the beautiful Applegate and Little Applegate Valleys returning to the Griffin Creek area and winding through the hills of south Medford on the same route as The Bartlett.
